### WASHINGTON COUNTY CHILDRENS CHORUS ANNOUNCES FREE HOLIDAY CONCERTS

The Washington County Children's Chorus will present three concerts during the first weekend of December. On Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 PM the WCCChorus will perform at the Peoples United Methodist Church, 86 Summit Street, Baileyville. Later that day, at 6:30 PM the Chorus will repeat their performance at the Second Baptist Church, 21 Church Street, Calais. On Sunday, December 6<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 PM the Chorus will appear again at Centre Street Congregational Church UCC, Machias. All performances will be followed by refreshments. Admission to the concerts is free. Donations will be accepted.

The WCCChorus is a gathering of Washington County youngsters between the ages of seven and the completion of high school who sing all types of chorale music in a live format. Harmony, special ensembles, selected soloists and attention to performance excellence all add to this opportunity for musical growth and a commitment to the arts. A non-profit organization which charges no fees for participation, the WCCChorus relies on the support of the chorister's parents, local business, grants, and the generous donations of individuals.

The WCCChorus recently released a new compact disk, "Peace, Light and Joy Across the World" which will be available at the concerts. A few copies of their 2001 CD "A Little Downeast Christmas" are also available.

In addition to local performances, the Chorus has performed with superstar Judy Collins at the Maine Center for Performing Arts in Orono. Concert tours have included trips to Chicago, Washington DC, and the Duchy of Luxembourg. A return trip to Luxembourg to help celebrate the 750<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the City of Diekirch and the 35<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Luxembourg Childrens Choir is planned for June, 2010.
